Shopping online: If you're making a purchase from a company or person you don't know and trust, carry out some research first, and ask a friend or family member for advice before completing the purchase. Where possible, use a credit card to make the payment, as most major credit card providers insure online purchases.



Phishing – Have you been caught out?



- You start getting lot of emails
- Unsolicited 'Anti-Virus' scans start cropping up
- Emails or phone calls from 'Microsoft'
- New browser toolbars
- Redirection from websites and excessive pop-ups
- Messages to friends and contacts
- Passwords not working
- New software is installed
- You're missing money
- Your computer is a brick

Take 5



- Never disclose security details, such as your PIN or full password it's never right to reveal these details
- Don't assume an email request or caller is genuine people aren't always who they say they are
- Don't be rushed a bank or genuine organisation won't mind waiting to give you time to stop and think
- Listen to your instincts if something feels wrong then it is usually right to pause and question it
- Stay in control have the confidence to refuse unusual requests for information


