More volunteers will be welcome to help with the rota. Practice session will be planned so that volunteers can have training making the coffees and understand set up.

Advertising: flyers will be made for letterbox drops, will also place Sandwich Board in village (both ends) and use social media.

Funding: To date, the village hall has gifted £100, John Harrison has donated £100 and Corfe Community Trust have given £50 to the initiative. All profits will go back into the Village Hall. If successful, the cafe will continue on a regular basis after the initial trial period. Might explore quarterly breakfast & newspaper morning (Sue Ford suggestion)
