Corfe Village Hall Factsheet

Who can hire the Village Hall and what is it used for? Anyone can hire the Hall. It is used for a wide range of activities including family parties, meetings, flower shows, as a polling station, charity events, a pop-up restaurant, village quizzes, Christmas parties, wedding receptions, christenings, as a community cafe and a range of regular activities such as those listed below. It is open for use seven days a week including bank holidays.

What happens when? The Village Hall has a regular booking on most days of the week, very occasionally the regular slot does not take place so check online first

How do I join one of these regular activities? Just email the organiser.

How do I book the Hall for an event I want to hold? Always look online first to see if the date is free and then email Chris Brown on corfevillagehall@gmail.com or 07754 571782

How much does it cost to hire the Hall? We charge £50 for the first 2 hours and £15 per hour thereafter. Corfe residents [and those living in the immediate vicinity] get a 20% discount. The 30 minutes either side of the event are free. Whole day bookings will have individual charges. Chris can discuss with you.

What facilities are in the Hall? The Hall comes with all the facilities likely to be needed to hold a social event including a fully equipped kitchen, chairs, tables, music system etc. The hall has free 5G Wifi. More detail see: https://www.corfevillagesomerset.org.uk/facilities-and-booking-info/) If you have not used the Hall before then we will arrange for Chris Brown to meet with you and show you everything.

Parking? There is parking for 11 cars only immediately outside the Hall. Further parking is available across the road in the church car park in Mill Lane. Hirer must ensure that those using the Hall do not obstruct rights of way or park on the private road to Barton Grange. No parking is allowed on the field.

How do I pay? Payment is made by either paying cash on the day or via a BACS payment at the end of the month that the booking takes place. When confirming the booking you will be asked to say which method of payment you will be using.
