#### **Rules for entry:**

The show is open to amateur gardeners, cooks & crafters in the parish of Corfe, along with their relatives & friends.

All entries in sections A & B must be grown by the exhibitor.

Entry fee for adult classes is 30p per entry.

Children's entry fee is 10p per entry.

Exhibitors may only submit one variety entry per class.

Awards: First: 6 points, Second: 4 points, Third: 2 points, Fourth: 1 point

The decision of the judge is final.

- Class 1: 3 Potatoes, 1 variety displayed on a plate to fit

Class 2: 3 Beet, round, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 3: 3 Onions, under 3”, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 4: 3 Onions, over 3”, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 5: 3 Chilli Peppers, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 6: 3 Standard Tomatoes, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 7: 3 Cherry Tomatoes, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 8: 3 Novelty Tomatoes, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 9: 6 Runner Beans, 1 variety

Class 10: 6 French Beans, 1 variety, display on a plate to fit

Class 11: 3 Carrots inc 2” top, 1 variety

Class 12: 1 Cucumber

Class 13: 5 Shallots, 1 variety, displayed on a plate to fit

Class 14: 3 Courgettes, 1 variety

Class 15: 1 Cabbage, cauliflower or broccoli head
- Class 16: 1 Marrow or 1 Pumpkin, any variety

Class 17: 2 Parsnips inc 2” top, 1 variety

Class 18: 2 Leeks, 1 variety

Class 19: Any veg/fruit not listed, 2 of each kind

Class 20: 3 Cooking Apples, 1 variety

Class 21: 3 Eating Apples, 1 variety

Class 22: 3 Pears, 1 variety

Class 23: 3 Plums, 1 variety

Class 24: A small plate of berries, 3 of each kind

Class 25: A bunch of fresh mixed herbs in a jam jar

Class 26: Heaviest Onion by weight

Class 27: Heaviest Marrow/Pumpkin by weight

Class 28: Longest Runner Bean

Class 29: Heaviest Potato by weight

Class 30: Heaviest tomato

Class 31: Collection of fruit/vegetables, 5 kinds displayed attractively in a maximum space 60cm wide x 45cm deep. Not less than 2 of each kind (one of cabbage/cauliflower/pumpkin/marrow)
